



Martin Kitchener - Getting Real about Healthcare Improvement



Professor Martin Kitchener BSc (Econ) Hons MBA PhD works at Cardiff Business School where he serves as Associate Dean, and Director of Cardiff Healthcare Organization and Policy Studies (CHOPS). Martin's research concentrates on issues of organisation, performance and policy in health and social care.

In the UK, he has led externally-funded studies of settings including hospitals, residential children's care, and mental

health. Between 1999 and 2007 Martin worked at the University of California (Berkeley and San Francisco) where he studied long-term care, academic health centres, and dentistry. The outputs of his research are published widely and have had considerable impact on practice and policy.

Martin is currently leading a major NHS SDO-funded study of organisational features associated with the successful implementation of hospital patient safety/improvement initiatives.
