Martin Marshall is Clinical Director and Director of R&D at the Health Foundation, an independent charity which aims to improve the quality of health care across the UK. He was previously Deputy Chief Medical Officer and Director General at the Department of Health, with responsibility for clinical quality and safety and medical education, and has worked as a General Practitioner for over 20 years.

Martin has written over 140 publications in the field of quality of care. He is a fellow of the Royal College of General Practitioners and chairs the College's Ethics Committee. He is also a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and the Faculty of Public Health Medicine, and has advised health and professional bodies, governments and international organisations around the world. In 2005 he was awarded a CBE for Services to Health Care and in 2008 he was appointed as a commissioner for the Care Quality Commission.
