

VISITING INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP in patient safety research methods

NIHR King's Patient Safety and Service Quality Research Centre (King's PSSQ) has established a **Visiting International Fellowship (VIF) scheme** to foster the development of research in patient safety and service quality. Between one and three Fellowships are awarded by competition each year.

The VIF awards are open to those who would value the opportunity to advance patient safety and service quality research. A financial award (to a maximum of £3,000 per Fellowship, awarded on a case by case basis) will be made as a contribution towards travel and subsistence expenses incurred in holding the Fellowship. Award-holders should be prepared to visit the Centre on one or more occasions during the academic year for a total duration of at least one month. VIFs will become honorary Research Fellows of King's College London and be entitled to use the University Library and other facilities. The holder of a Fellowship is usually a permanent resident outside the United Kingdom.

King's PSSQ is funded by the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR). The Centre was established to drive improvements in the safety, quality and effectiveness of the services the NHS provides to its patients and the public. It was formed through a strong working partnership that brings together the expertise of King's College Hospital NHS Foundation Trust, and King's College London. Senior members of staff from both organisations are working together to focus on investigating ways to improve the care of patients. Applications must be made on the form below, with completed forms submitted by email as an attachment to sharron.preston@kcl.ac.uk. All applicants will need to carry out work in an area that links directly to the work of King's PSSQ, and proposals for collaborative research with King's PSSQ staff are especially welcome. We would expect any applicant to have had informal discussions with a senior person in PSSQ prior to submitting an application.
